Proposed Election Rules

1. Decisions will be governed by the following in order of priority;
 - a. County Party Constitution & Bylaws
 - b. State Party Constitution & Bylaws
 - c. State Law
2. All declared republican candidates for county or legislative office will be placed in nomination. No additional notice to the party is required.
3. All voting shall be by secret ballot
4. Voting Method will be multiple rounds
 - a. 1st round will select top 3 candidates
 - b. 2nd round select top 2 candidates
 - c. Final round will identify the nominee
 - d. A candidate that receives 60% of the vote in any round will be declared the nominee.
5. These rules shall be ratified by majority consent of the delegates
6. Results will be announced at the close of convention & promptly reported by certified mail to the county clerk.
7. Only duly elected delegates or their appointed substitutes will be credentialed & allowed to participate in convention.
8. Candidate speeches will be limited to 3 minutes each for the 1st round. Candidates progressing to subsequent rounds of voting will be allowed 30 seconds each.
9. Roberts Rules of order shall be relied on for any dispute not addressed by these rules or the documents referenced.
