Utah Voter Turnout History from 1980 to 2012



Prior to 1996, and with the caucus system in place Utah voter turnout was +9% above the national average. In the last election we were about 3% below the national average but since 1996 our voter turnout has steadily increased. Looking at the stats we can't see how anybody can claim that the caucus system has a negative impact on voter turnout.

One possibility could be that Utah's population growth had an impact. Voters new to the state are less familiar with the caucus system and it takes some time for them to become assimilated . Perhaps the migration from other states has influenced turnout. If the "Count My Vote Group" claims to want to fix the low turnout issue then perhaps they should first figure out what are the key contributing factors.
